Recommendations for Management of Orphaned or Fostered Animals

When orphaned animals are recovered from the fields they will be suffering from the stress of relocation, hypothermia and a deficiency in colostrum. In many cases these animals will develop scours and indeed the most frequent cause of death is dehydration. PharmaZen's recommended management strategy for successful recovery and fostering of animals is:

- 1) Place the animals in a box that has a heated animal / lamb pad and /or heat light.
- 2) Immediately give each animal one dose of **ColoZen™**.
- 3) Commence feeding with a half-strength solution of your favourite milk replacer.
- 4) For animals that are **scouring** use an appropriate oral re-hydration fluid or anti-scouring agent (for example PharmaZen's **ScourZen™**) and give a second dose of **ColoZen™** two (2) hours after the initial dose.
- 5) Continue with the re-hydration fluid for at least 24 hours and then feed milk replacer at 20% of the recommended strength. As the animal's health improves increase the milk replacer concentration.
- 6) Where possible foster onto mothers that are restricted within an appropriate area.
